



# BUSINESS SPANISH

### DESCRIPTION

Business Spanish is a combination course with our Intensive Spanish 20 and 4 specialized individual lessons during the week. This course is for those wishing to improve their language skills related to the professional environment. Topics included industry-specific vocabulary (finance, engineering, etc.), CV writing and interviews, professional emails and written communication, and presentations.

### QUICKFACTS

- 20 regular group lessons + 4 ind. business Spanish lessons per week
- Begin every Monday
- For high beginners to advanced students
- Minimum of 1 week, maximum of 30 weeks
- Average of 6 students in class, maximum of 12
- Schedule - mornings and afternoons
- 1 group lesson is 50 minutes, 1 ind. lesson is 55 minutes

### WHY STUDY BUSINESS SPANISH IN ARGENTINA?

Taking a Business Spanish course in Argentina makes great business sense:
